OPERATION MANUAL

Thank you for purchasing the ϕ 30 Oil Mist Type Reducer " RG-3004M ". This reducer was developed for reducing the spindle rotation speed while increasing the motor torque. This Reducer is designed to be connected between the Motor and the Spindle. The E3000 CONTROLLER, Spindle, Brushless Motor and Air Line Kit are required to drive this Reducer. Read this and all the associated component Operation Manuals carefully before use. Always keep this Operation Manual in a place where a user can referred to for reference at any time.

1. CAUTIONS FOR HANDLING AND OPERATION =

- Read these warnings and cautions carefully and only use in the manner intended
- These warnings and cautions are intended to avoid potential hazards that could result in personal injury to the operator or damage to the device. These are classified as follows in accordance with the seriousness of the risk.

🕂 WARNING -

- ① The Reducer is not a hand tool. It is to be connected between the NSK spindle and brushless motor and installed on a CNC machine or a special designed machine.
- 2 Do not touch the cutting tool while it is running. It is very dangerous.
- 3 Wear safety glasses, dust mask and use a protective cover around the Reducer whenever the Reducer is rotating.
- ④ Never connect, disconnect or touch the Power Cord Plug or Motor Cord Plug with wet hands. This may cause an electric shock.
- (5) Never operate or handle the Reducer until you have thoroughly read the Operation Manuals and safe operation has been confirmed.
 - 1) To prevent injuries / damages, check the brushless motor, Reducer, spindle and cutting tool for proper installation, before operating the brushless motor, Reducer, spindle and cutting tool.
 - 2) Before disconnecting the Reducer from the brushless motor and spindle, always turn the control power off and turn the compressed air supply to the CONTROLLER off. Then it is safe to remove the Reducer.

- 🕂 CAUTION -


- ① This reducer uses an oil mist. If oil is not supplied to the Reducer, damage to the internal components of the Reducer will occur.
- 2 Before use, carefully read " CONTROLLER, brushless motor, spindle, air line kit Operation Manuals " regarding the correct connection, operation and cautions when using the CONTROLLER, brushless motor, spindle, air line kit.
- **③** Do not exceed the maximum allowable motor speed of 60,000min⁻¹ (rpm).
- ④ Do not drop or hit this Reducer, as shock can damage to the internal components.
- **5** Make sure that the transmission clutches engage firmly, when connecting to the brushless motor and the spindle.
- **6** Stop working immediately when abnormal rotation or unusual vibration are observed. Immediately, please check the content of section "7. TROUBLESHOOTING".
- ⑦ After installation, repair, initial operation, or long periods of non operation, please carry out break - in as follow. Start rotating slowly and over a short period of time, increase speed gradually until allowable maximum speed.
- ⑧ Do not disassemble, modify or attempt to repair this reducer. Additional damage will occur to the internal components. Service must be performed by NSK NAKANISHI or an authorized service center.
- (9) When using this Reducer for mass production, please consider the purchase of an additional Reducer to be used as a back-up in case of emergency.
- 10 Securely connect the air / oil hose to the brushless motor and air line kit to avoid accidental disconnection and injury to the operator during use.

4. CONNECTION OF THE REDUCER TO THE MOTOR -

- AUTION -

Make sure your hands and all interlocking parts of the Reducer and brushless motor are clean before connecting the Reducer to the brushless motor. This is critical in preventing contaminants from entering the brushless motor or Reducer.

Align the thread on the front end of the brushless motor and the rear of the Reducer, and turn the reducer clockwise. If the drive shaft of the brushless motor does not engage properly to the drive dog on the Reducer, it may only turn aprroximately two threads before stopping. DO NOT FORCE THEM TOGETHER. Loosen the reducer from the brushless motor, rotate the Reducer shaft by hand then re-try. The drive shaft and the drive dog must be fully engaged. When fully engaged, secure the brushless motor and Reducer using the provided 27mm wrench. (Fig. 2)



5. SYSTEM CHART -

The Oil Mist Type Reducer can be used with the following systems.




CONNECTION OF THE MIST AIR LINE KIT (AL - M1201BL) TO THE OIL MIST TYPE REDUCER —

- ① Connect the Connection Joint (Air Line Kit's Standard Accessory) to the Primary Joint of the Air Line Kit.
- (2) Connect the ϕ 6mm air hose to the Air Output Joint on the CONTROLLER. Connect the other side of the ϕ 6mm air hose to the Connection Joint of the Primary Joint of the Air Line Kit.
- 3 Insert one end of the \$\phi 4mm air / oil hose (Motor Cord's Standard Accessory) into the back of the motor.
- 4 Insert the other end of the \$\phi4mm\$ air / oil hose (Motor Cord's Standard Accessory) into the Secondary Joint (\$\phi6\$ One - Touch Joint) of the Air Line Kit. Use the provided Reducer (\$\phi 6mm - \$\phi 4mm Adaptor : CONTROLLER's Standard Accessory).
- ⑤ Turn the Regulator Knob, adjust the air pressure to between the 0.25 0.3MPa.
- 6 Turn the Adjusting Dome on the Lubricator, adjusting the Oil Drip Rate to between 1 3 drops / min.



2. FEATURES =

- ① When the reducer is connected between the spindle and the motor, it reduces the spindle rotation speed and increases the torque while keeping the motor speed unchanged.
- 2 The reducer housing is made from precision ground, hardened, stainless steel (SUS) with an outside diameter of *\$*30mm.
- ③ The Reducer utilizes a planetary gear system.

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

3 - 2 Outside View







7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If a problem or concern occurs, please check the following prior to consulting your dealer.

Trouble	Cause	inspection / Corrective Action
Spindle does not rotate or rotate	The Reducer bearings have been damaged.	Replace the ball bearings. (Return to NAKANISHI dealer service.)
smoothly.	The Reducer gears have been damaged.	Replace the inner gears. (Return to NAKANISHI dealer service.)
Overheating during rotation.	Cutting debris has contaminated the ball bearings, and the ball bearings are damaged.	Replace the ball bearings. (Return to NAKANISHI dealer service.)
Abnormal vibration or noise during rotation.	Cutting debris has contaminated the ball bearing.	
	The spindles bearings have been damaged.	
	The Reducer gears have been damaged.	Replace the inner gears. (Return to NAKANISHI dealer service.)
